Take part in the Bugbrooke Garden Birdwatch on 29th-30th January. It coincides with the RSPB Big Garden Birdwatch, so that you can send your results to them to help in the national survey, as well as helping us to know what is happening locally. Last year was the first time we tried to do a local survey and I had 18 sets of results, but obviously it would be better to have more! Some parts of the village were very poorly represented and your involvement would make a huge difference.

The rules are the same as for the RSPB. All you have to do is watch for 1 hour during the weekend, noting each species you see and the maximum number of that species you see **together at one time**. Do not count the total number you see in the hour, as many will be birds that have returned. You would expect to see 1, 2, 3, or 4, although some species do come in greater numbers.

Hoping that you will take part, I have given you a tally form, which should be returned at the latest to 1 Browns Yard by 15th February.
