Volunteering in August 1914, he proceeded to France in the following July, and saw heavy fighting in the Ypres sector. He was transferred to the 2nd Gloucestershire Regiment in November 1915, and was drafted to Salonika, where he was in action on the Doiran and the Vardar fronts. On December 9th, 1916, he was severely wounded and unhappily succumbed to his injuries three days later. He was entitled to the 1914-15 Star, and the General Service and Victory Medals.
