Fred was born in Bugbrooke, the son of Francis Frederick and Ellen Elizabeth Chapman. Francis was a blacksmith in the village. Fred was only 14 at the start of the war and it is not known when he enlisted and joined the Royal Fusiliers (City of London Regiment) with Service number 82031. He fought and died on the 14<sup>th</sup> October 1918 at the Ypres Salient. He was only nineteen. He has no known grave and is commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial at Zonnebeke in Belgium.
